What's the GDPR all about?



The **General Data Protection Regulation** is a new document, which helps your doctor's surgery keep the information about you safe.

People who look after your information are called data controllers and the people who use your data are called data processors.





You can ask to see the information we hold about you at any time. If you're under 16 but over 12, you may be able to do this yourself.

Consent means you allow us to use your information for the purpose of your care.
Parental consent is required if you're under 16.
